- scalpel blades (at least 6)
- mirror(s) for retraction
- periosteal elevator(s)*
- curved hemostat
- curettes
- needle holder
- suture scissors
- gloves
- round burs (various sizes #2-6)
- sutures (3-4)
- scalpel handle(s)
- tissue plier (college plier will do)
- gingivectomy knife
- surgical hose (Solt back-kirkland 15-16)
- action chisel

* Larger periosteal elevators such as Molt 9 are great for thick tissue but can tear thin tissue. Pritchard 3 is nice for thin, delicate tissue.
