The Nightingale Pledge (Abridged)

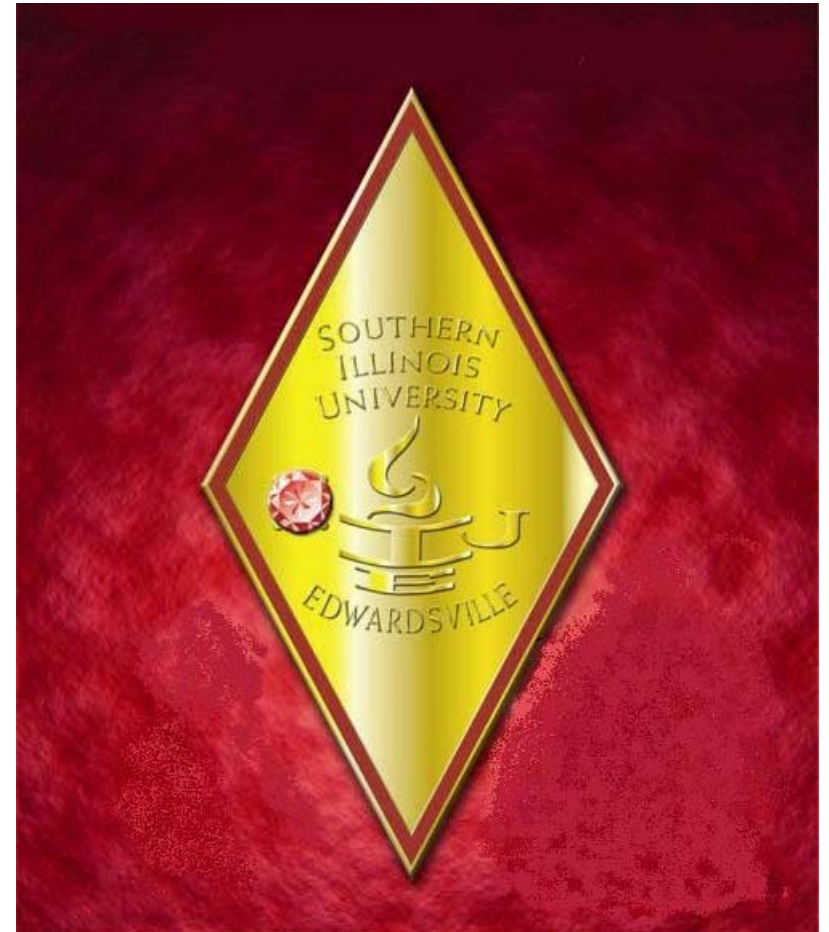
I Solemnly Pledge Myself Before God and
